

Run for Charity events

Terms and Conditions

As a condition of accepting a charity place for your chosen event through the Run for Charity platform, you are agreeing to the following terms and conditions:

1. You agree to pay a non-refundable registration fee (plus booking fee) to secure your place in the event.
2. You commit to raise the minimum fundraising target expected for this event (excluding Gift Aid). Your sponsorship money should be banked with the charity 4 weeks after the event. You may only fundraise for the Royal Osteoporosis Society.
3. You will commit to having raised 80% of your fundraising target by the date specified by the Royal Osteoporosis Society. Failure to meet this target will result in the charity withdrawing you from the event.
4. You will inform us at the earliest opportunity if you are unable to take part in the event for any reason.
5. You will inform us at the earliest opportunity if you feel that you will not be able to fulfil your sponsorship pledge. This will enable us to provide you with additional support.
6. You must ensure that you are medically fit to participate in the event. You take part at your own risk. The Royal Osteoporosis Society does not accept any responsibility for any injury, loss or damage incurred prior to, during, or resulting from, participating in the event. If you are in any doubt, or experience any medical symptoms, seek medical advice.
7. You must ensure that you are able to complete the event in line with timescales set by event officials.
8. Any images, video, audio or quotes obtained on the event day or on any other occasion relating to your event, may be used by the Royal Osteoporosis Society to promote future events.
