### **Fundraising**

3. This event can't be used as a means to raise funds for an alternative charity – all funds raised must be raised for the ROS and our central bank account.
4. Any funds raised should be donated to the ROS within 4 weeks of your chosen event date.

### **Facebook group**

5. The Facebook group is optional for this event – you don't have to join if you don't want to.
6. By joining the group, you agree to the rules stipulated by the group admins within the group.
