Bath Half Marathon 2024 Terms and Conditions

As a condition of registering for a charity place for the Bath Half Marathon as part of the Royal Osteoporosis Society's team, you are agreeing to the following terms and conditions:

1. You agree to pay a non-refundable registration fee of £35 to secure your place in the event.
2. You commit to raise the minimum fundraising target of £200 (excluding Gift Aid). Your sponsorship money should be banked with the charity 4 weeks after the event. You may only fundraise for the Royal Osteoporosis Society with this event place.
3. The charity reserve the right to change elements of the event including but not limited to the registration fee cost, the fundraising target, the location of the cheer point on the day etc.
4. The logistics of the race are controlled by Running High (the team behind the Bath Half Marathon), and we as the charity are not responsible for any logistics of the event. Should you have a question, query or complaint about the event, please contact Running High.
5. If the event is postponed or cancelled due to force majeure, we will contact you immediately with our plan and the options available to you.
6. You will commit to having raised **80% (£160) of your fundraising target by the 4 March 2024**. Failure to meet this target may result in the charity withdrawing you from the event.
7. You will inform us at the earliest opportunity if you are unable to take part in the event for any reason.
8. You will inform us at the earliest opportunity if you feel that you will not be able to fulfil your sponsorship pledge. This will enable us to provide you with additional support.
9. You must ensure that you are medically fit to participate in the event. You take part at your own risk. The Royal Osteoporosis Society does not accept any responsibility for any injury, loss or damage incurred prior to, during, or resulting from, participating in the event. If you are in any doubt, or experience any medical symptoms, seek medical advice before applying for a place.
10. The roll-over of spaces in this event to the 2025 Bath Half Marathon is decided at the charities discretion.
11. You must ensure that you are able to complete the event in line with timescales set by event officials.
