

The waiting lists for DXA will be years long – how do we ever catch up?





We must change our FLS completely – no more one stop clinics-patients will either get a telephone call or a video call




Survey data: FLS and DXA services









Survey data: IV and denosumab treatments








Survey data: Inpatient and Outpatient services











