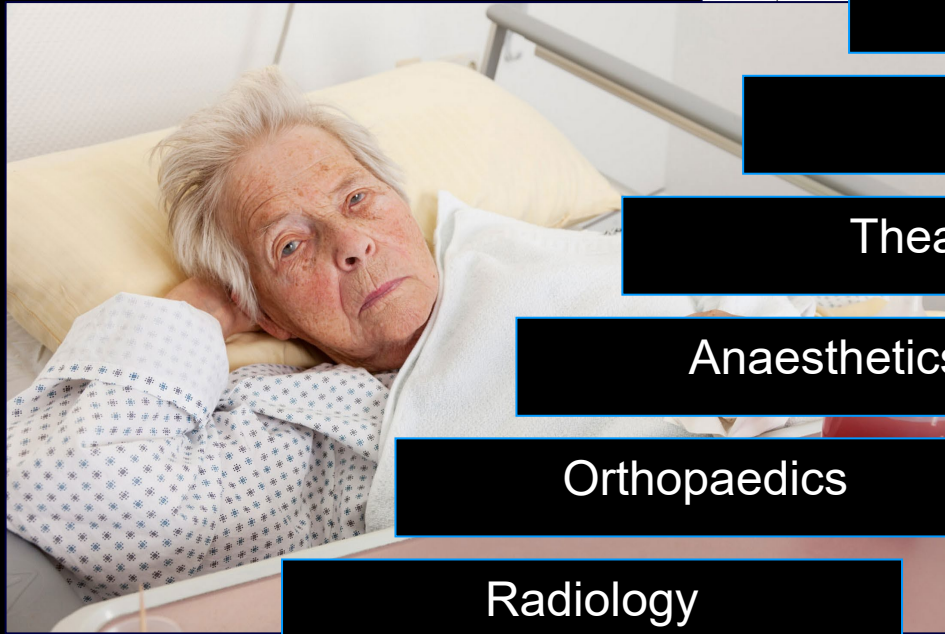

What can I tell her and her family when she arrives?

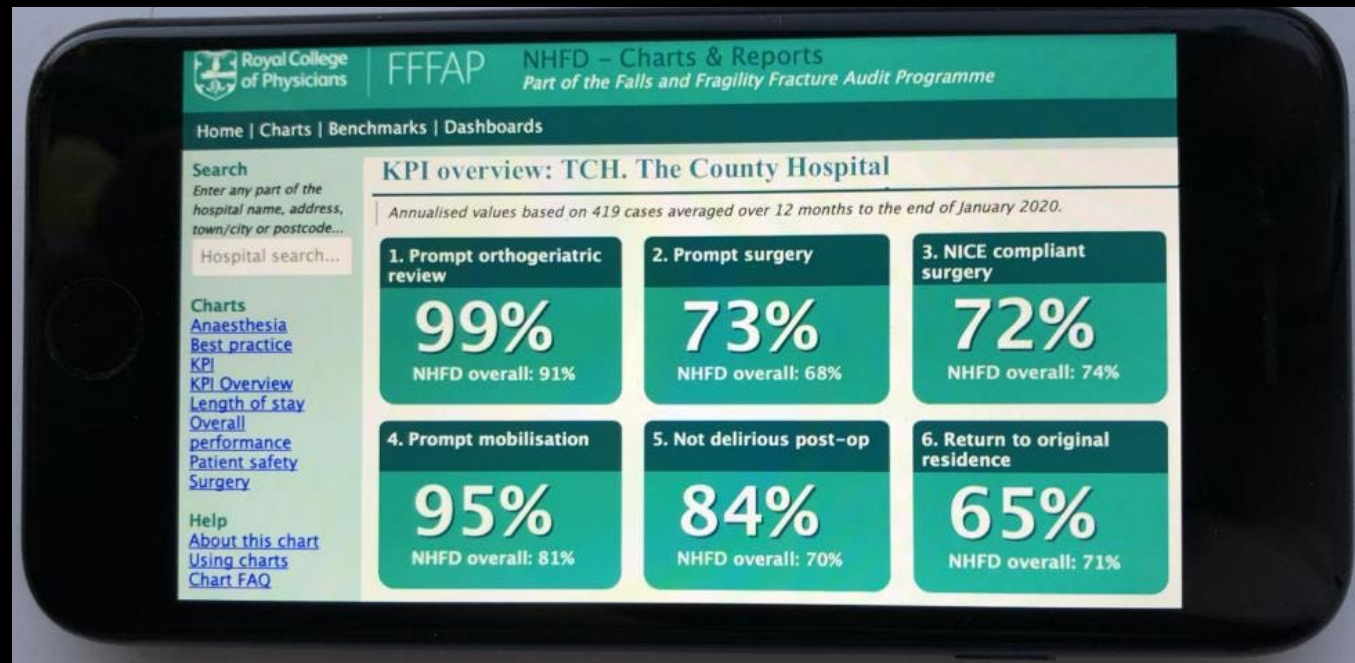
You are likely to receive surgery by tomorrow

You are likely to get up by 3 days from now

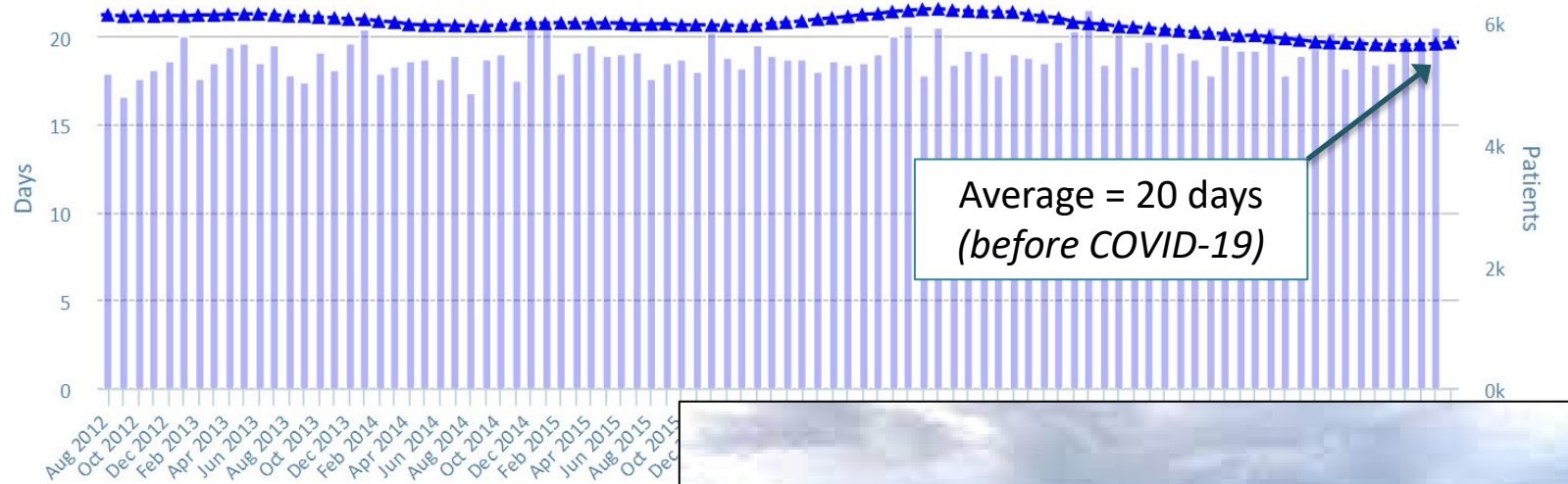
You have a 1 in 4 chance of becoming confused

Over £1 billion per year

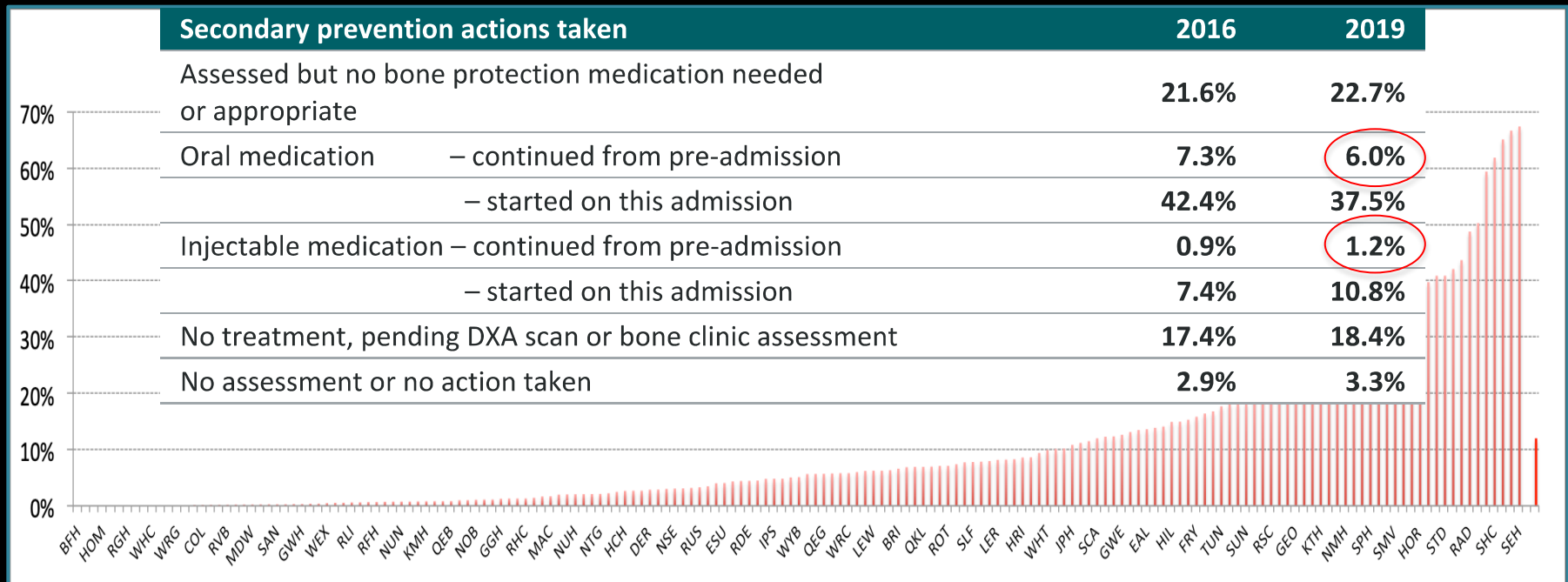
What can I tell her and her family about her bones?

In my hospital you will have your bone health assessed to avoid future fractures

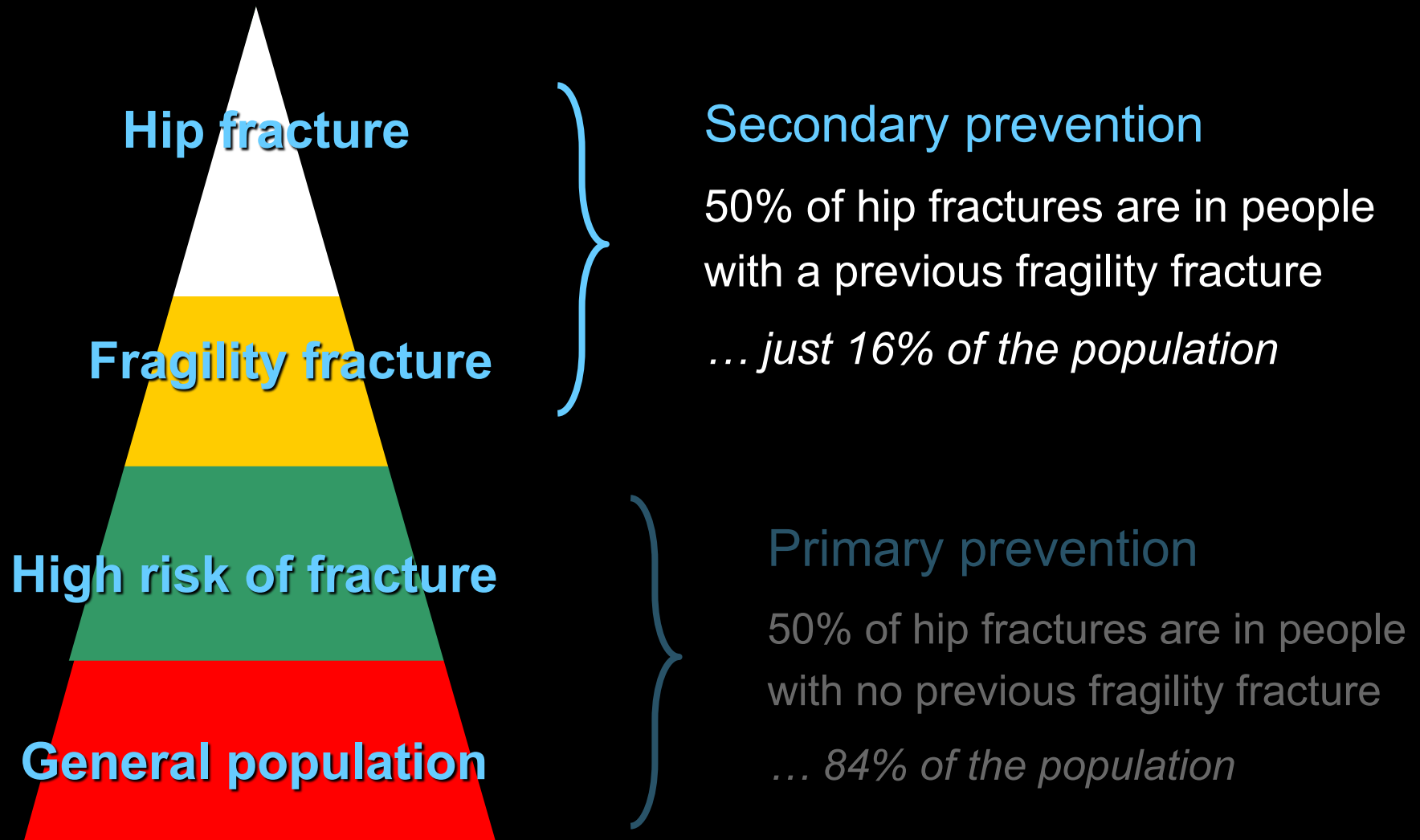
... but figures vary from 6-100% in other hospitals around the country

In my hospital we will check you're still receiving bone protection in 4 months

... but around the country only 1 in 4 people are known to be doing so
